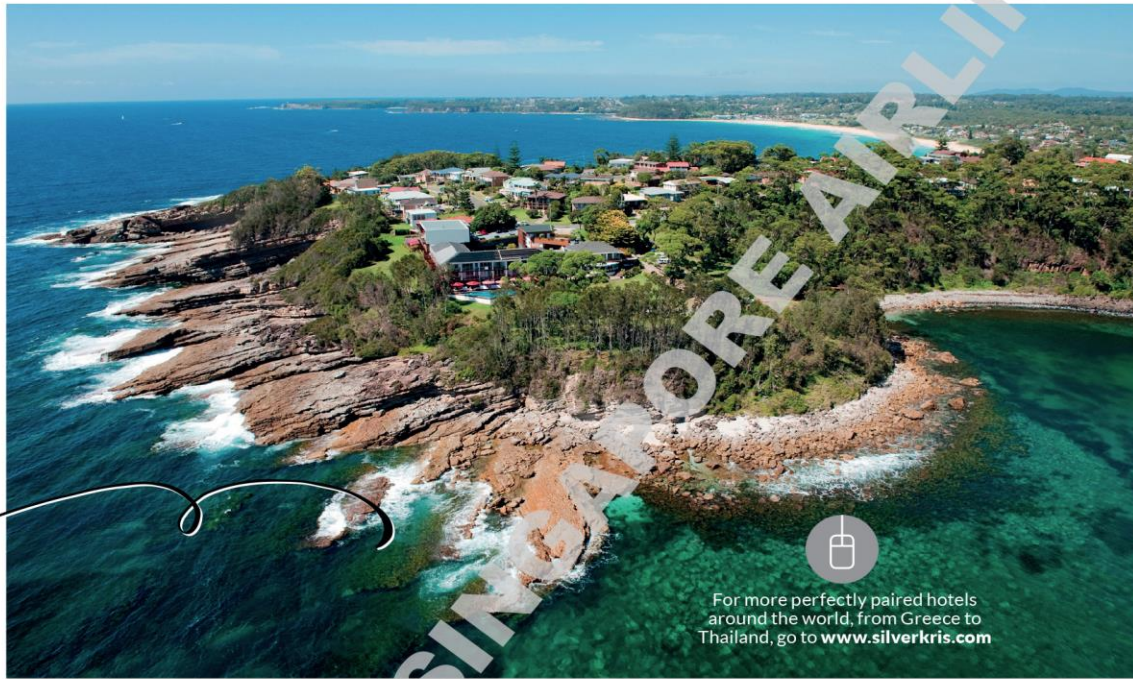


# Double vision

Guests of sister hotels Bannisters by the Sea and Bannisters Pavilion ([www.bannisters.com.au](http://www.bannisters.com.au); above) – located just 800m apart on the south coast of NSW, Australia – can hop on courtesy vehicles, and enjoy the two's shared day spa and restaurants, including Rick Stein at Bannisters. In South Africa, Singita Sweni Lodge and Singita Lebombo Lodge ([www.singita.com](http://www.singita.com); top left), separated by a short drive through Kruger National Park,

share a spa and curio shop full of original African treasures. And in the Italian Dolomites, the family-friendly Adler Dolomiti ([www.adler-dolomiti.com](http://www.adler-dolomiti.com)) and adults-only Adler Balance ([www.adler-balance.com](http://www.adler-balance.com)) – which sit on opposite sides of the road, but are connected by a private underground walkway – share spa and wellness facilities, as well as activities such as mountain-biking in summer and ski safaris in winter.
