The accommodation is set in the impressive The Mark Penthouse, which occupies the top two floors of the building with panoramic views of Central Park and the Manhattan skyline. Designed to function as a private club above the city, the suite features a 24-hour butler, on-call massage therapist, Technogym fitness center, and a cold plunge pool on the private terrace. Fine dining is provided by personalized menus created by Jean-Georges Vongerichten and Caviar Kaspia at The Mark, which also cater to evening cocktails on the terrace and leisure time watching matches on large screens throughout the space.

Guests embark on the hotel's own classic 21-meter Herreshoff sailboat, departing from Chelsea Piers towards the Statue of Liberty.
